

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

*Turn off power at switch before replacing bulbs, making sure fixture has had sufficient time to cool down.

*DO NOT subject the fixture to any shock while lit as shattering of bulbs may result.

*This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce risk of electric shock, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If it does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not

fit, contact a qualified electrician.

*Never use with an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted. DO NOT ALTER THE PLUG.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Remove all parts from carton. Do not throw away any parts.
- 2. Place base on a level surface.
- 3. Insert threaded end of boom arm (A) into threaded opening in swivel housing (B). Turn until hand tight.
- 4. Remove flange (E) from threaded socket (C).
- 5. Place shade spider, located inside shade (D), over threaded socket (C). Attach socket flange (O) to threaded socket (C) to secure shade (D) to lamp.
- 6. Insert one (1) 100W MAX Type A, medium base bulb in to socket (C).
- 7. Remove protective plastic (F) from polarized plug (G). Insert polarized plug (G) into wall outlet.

* To clean, wipe lamp with a soft dry cloth. Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners as they can damage the finish. *
